COACH TRIP to Stroud Valley, Gloucestershire, 27th June 2026

You can join the coach at either

- 9 am at Hanson Coaches’ yard - Unit 10, Budbrooke Industrial Estate, Budbrooke Road, Warwick CV34 5XH (street parking nearby) or
- 9.45 am at the Bus Station, Crown Close, Bromsgrove B61 8DA.

We intend to visit first Dunkirk Mill, Nailsworth – Mill with large workable waterwheel driving textile machinery. Then lunch break. One of the restaurants in Nailsworth is Egypt Mill, once a corn mill, where much of the machinery and the waterwheel can still be seen. There are a few alternative eating places or you can bring your own food. On the afternoon we intend to visit Gigg Mill (weaving shed, looms on display, and demonstration of weaving) and then journey to Chalford to see St Mary’s Mill (waterwheel, steam engine, machinery for fulling; also a short walk along the towpath reveals interesting structures relating to the canal, railway and the exterior of another mill). Return to be back in Bromsgrove about by 6.15 and Warwick by 7pm.

Cost: £46 per head. (This includes £20 total entrance to mills, but not food.)
